An ACT to authorife and empower the levy court of Montgomery Jan. 1798. county to affels and levy annually a fum of money for the support of Jemima Thompson. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 613.

WHEREAS Jemima Thompson, of Montgomery county, by her petition to this general assemble. bly hath set forth, that she is in her old age, and entirely deprived of the use of her limbs, by frequent attacks of the rheumatism, and has no other dependence whereby to subsist but on the benevolence and care of ner affectionate daughter, who is very poor, and prays an act may pals to provide for her future maintenance out of the poor's house; and the facts stated in said petition appearing to be true, therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the justices of Montgomery county Money to be shall be and are hereby directed and empowered, at their levy court annually, so long as they shall levied, &c. fee cause, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county a sum of money, not exceeding forty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the said Jemima Thompson, and that the same be collected and paid annually by the collector of Montgomery county to fuch person as the levy court of faid county shall or may direct. XXXIII.

An ACT to authorise and empower the levy court of Saint-Mary's county to affess and levy annually a fum of money for the support of Bennett Thompson, son of Elizabeth Thompson.
