money, &c.

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the justices of the said county shall, and they are hereby authorised, empowered and directed, to affels and levy at their next levy court, in equal proportions on all the affelfable property within the faid county, the fum of two thousand dollars, and fuch further fum at the time of laying the county rate in the year feventeen hundred and ninety-nine, as may be thought necessary by the said trustees, or their successors, for the purposes mentioned and intended by this act, and the act to which this is a supplement, not exceeding two thousand dollars, together with the collector's commission on each sum of six per centum for collecting the same; which faid rate or assessment, so as aforesaid to be assessed and levied, shall be collected by the collector of the faid county in the same manner, and at the same time, as the county rate is collected, and when so as aforesaid collected, shall be paid by the said collector to the said trustees, and their successors, who are hereby authorifed and required to receive and apply the fame to the uses and purposes herein after directed.

VIII. AND BE ET ENACTED, That the faid trustees and their successors, shall be and they are Trustees to hereby authorifed, directed and required, to purchase, in see-simple, by the name aforesaid, a piece purchase land, or quantity of land in the faid county, not exceeding feven acres, and fituate and being as near and as convenient as may be to the court-house of said county, and not exceeding seven miles therefrom, and to agree and contract with a workman or workmen to undertake, erect, build, and in a workmanlike manner to complete and finish, on the said land, when so purchased, a good, strong, sufficient and convenient house, for the reception of the poor of the said county, and of such vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and offenders, as shall be committed thereto by virtue of the act to which this is a supplement, and they shall appropriate one part thereof, to be called the alms-house, to and for the reception and lodging of the poor of the faid county, and another part or parts thereof, to be called the work-houle, and for the reception and lodging of all fuch vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and offenders, as shall be committed thereto by virtue of the act to which this is a supplement; and the aforefaid land and house shall be, and are hereby declared to be, vested in the said trustees, and their fuccessors, for ever, for the uses and purposes by this act directed and expressed, and the act to which this is a supplement.

IX. And, to enable the faid truftees to purchase the said land, to erect an alms and work-house thereon, and for other purposes mentioned and directed in this act, and the act to which this is a supplement, BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, and their successors, be and they are hereby authorifed and empowered, from time to time, as occasion may require, to draw upon the collector of the faid county for all and any part of the money which shall or may be affessed, levied and collected, by virtue of this act, and the act to which this is a supplement, and which shall or may be or remain in the hands of the faid collector.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, or the major part of them, shall and they are And purchase hereby authorised, directed and required, after the house aforesaid shall be completely erected and beds, &c. finished, to buy and purchase, for the use and employment of the poor of said county, and of the vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and offenders, who shall be committed thereto by virtue of the act to which this is a supplement, beds, bedding, working tools, kitchen utensils, cows, horses, and other necessaries; to keep a fair, distinct and clear account, in writing, of all the monies by them received and expended by virtue of this act, and the act to which this is a supplement, and to return a true copy thereof, on oath, and shew and produce the vouchers to support the same, to the justices of said county, at their May courts yearly, to be by the said justices inspected and examined; which said accounts shall be lodged with the clerk of the said court.

XI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the justices of the faid county shall, and they are hereby em- Justices to levy powered and directed, to affels and levy in the year eighteen addred, and annually for ever there- money, &c. after, on all the property in faid county subject and liable to affeliment, at the time of laying their county rate, fuch sum of current money as by the said trustees, and their successors, may be thought necessary, not exceeding three shillings and nine-pence on every hundred pounds of property as aforesaid, in said county, together with the collector's commission of six per cent. for collecting the same; which said assessment shall be made, levied and collected, in the same manner as herein before directed, and when so collected, shall be paid by the collector to the said trustees, and their succeffors, or to their order under their common feal, who are hereby authorised and required to receive and apply the same to and for the use, benefit and charge, of maintaining the said poor, vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and offenders, in the purchasing provisions, and other necessaries, for use and labour, in paying a doctor for his attendance, medicines and advice, in providing men and women fervants and nurses, to be under the direction and management of the overseer of such alms
