the furface thereof, or shall in any other manner fail or neglect to perform the duties of an overseer of the faid roads, according to the directions of this act, every fuch overfeer, fo failing or neglecting, shall forfeit and pay the sum of five dollars for every offence, except in the time of wheat harvest.

VIL THE BE IT ENACTED, That it fifall and may be lawful for the feveral and respective over- They may dig feers of the faid roads, and they are hereby authorifed and empowered, as often as need shall re- stones, &c. quire, to dig, take and remove, any stones, gravel, or earth of firm quality, which may be found on any land adjoining the roads for which the same may be necessary, and to employ the same in the repairing of the faid roads; and for the making or repairing of bridges over the heads of rivers, creeks, branches, swamps, or other low and miry places, through and over which the said roads may pals, to cut down, or cause to be cut down, any tree or tees growing on any of the next adjacent lands to such places where bridges may be necessary as aforesaid, and the same trees to a ful and carry away from off fuch lands, and to apply the same to the making or repairing of the said bridges; provided always, that no enclosures shall be laid open or entered into to obtain the several materials aforefaid, or any of them, without the confent of the owner or owners thereof; and provided also, that before any tree or trees shall be cut down for the purposes aforesaid, notice thereof shall be given to the owner, tenant or overseer, and due compensation made or secured to him or them by the county, according to the full value thereof, in fuch manner as the justices of the levy court shall direct and appoint.

VIII: AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid overfeers shall have full power, and they are hereby Call on all free authorifed and required, to call upon all and fingular the free male inhabitants of their respective male inhabitants of their respective limits above the age of twenty-one years, and upon all and fingular the male flaves refiding therein above the age of fixteen years, to labour and affift in clearing, amending, improving and repairing, the several and respective roads aforesaid, and to require such and so many of the said persons as they shall from time to time deem necessary, to assemble at such place within their respective limits, the faid overfeers thall feverally appoint, with fufficient implements of labour, and thereupon to proceed in the execution of fuch work and labour upon the faid roads, for the improvement and repair thereof, as the respective overseers shall order and direct; and the said overseers shall also have power to hire and employ carts and teams for the carrying and removing all fuch stones, dirt, gravel and timber, as may be deemed requifite for repairing and completing the faid roads and bridges, and the expence of fuch carts and teams shall be levied upon the county.

IX. AND BE IT ENACTED, That within one month after the receipt of their respective warrants, Take a lift of the several overseers aforesaid, under the directions of the said justices, shall repair to the house of names, &c. every tenant or proprietor reliding within the limits attached to their respective roads, and shall take own a proper lift of the names of all and fingular the free male inhabitants reliding therein above the age of twenty-one years, and of all the male flaves above the age of fixteen years; and the faid overfeers shall justly and impartially call for and require the labour of all and singular the persons aforesaid, alternately, and in such convenient numbers and classes as to place the burthen of their service equally upon all; provided nevertheless, that the labour of the said persons shall not be called forth for the purpoles of this act during the season of harvest, nor in such manner as to take more than half the number of labourers belonging to one family at the same time.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That as often as the faid overfeers shall judge it necessary to call upon Summon the the faid inhabitants for their labour in and upon the faid roads, they shall summon, or cause to be class arranged, fummoned, the number and class which they shall have previously arranged, having had regard to &c. the quantity and quality of work necessary to be done upon the said roads, giving each person, and the master, mistress or overseer of each servant or slave, so to be summoned, two days notice at the leaft, of the time and place appointed for their labour, except in such extraordinary cases which may require a shorter notice, and every person so summoned shall be obliged to attend in person, or to provide a sufficient substitute; and if any person, being so summened, shall neglect or resule to attend, or to provide a sufficient substitute, he shall forseit and pay the sum of one dollar for every offence; and if any person shall attend, and not perform the reasonable labour required of him by the overfeer of the road, according to his ability, he shall be adjudged a defaulter, and shall incur the same penalty as if he had neglected to attend; and in case the master, mistress or overseer, of any servant or slave, upon being notified as aforesaid, shall resuse or neglect to send such servant or flave, or upon fending, such fervant or flave shall refuse to perform his reasonable labour as aforesaid, fuch master, mistress or overseer, shall forfeit and pay the sum of one dollar for every servant or flave so refused to be sent, or when sent resusing to work as aforesaid.
