BEIT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the chancellor of this state for the time Additional albeing, as chancellor and judge of the land-onice, shall be entitled to receive four hundred and lowance. fixty-fix dollars and fifty-feven cents, in addition to the permanent falary fixed by law.

The falary increased to £. 1,275 0 0 by 1798, ch. 86, which has the same continuance as this act.

A Further supplement to an act \* to streighten and amend the public roads in Harford county, and for other purposes. Lib. JG. No. 2.

THEREAS Abraham, Jarrett and Hannah Crosmore have set forth by their petition to this Preamble. tol. 691. general affembly, that they are much aggrieved by the road leading from the Upper Crofs Roads to Benjamin Amols's mill, in faid county, as laid out by the commillioners appointed under the act to which this is a further supplement, and praying a power may be vested in the levy court of faid county to appoint commissioners to review the faid road; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the levy court of Harford county be and they are hereby empowered and directed to appoint, by warrant, five persons, freeholders and refidents of faid county, to review the above described road, which faid persons, so appointed as aforefaid, shall and they are hereby directed and required, as foon as conveniently may be thereafter, to meet, examine and review, the above described road, as laid out, marked and bounded as aforefaid, and if, upon fuch review, they, in their judgment, shall be of opinion that the above described road, laid out as aforesaid, ought to be altered, then they are hereby required to alter, lay out, survey, mark and bound the road aforesaid so altered, and make return thereof agreeably to the directions and regulations of the original act to which this is a further supplement; and the faid court, if they shall approve the same, thereupon shall direct the said road, so altered and laid out, to be cleared and amended in the same manner as is directed by the said original act.
