IX. And, whereas by an act of affembly, paffed at November fession, seventeen hundred and ninety-fix, * entitled, An act for building a record-office, and fecuring and transcribing certain records. Chapter 55. and papers, in Baltimore county, and rebuilding two bridges over Jones's falls, in Baltimore town, in faid county, it was among other things enacted, that the justices, of Baltimore county court shall levy and alless, on the assessable property of faid county, a sum not exceeding sive hundred pounds, to be applied to the building of a record-office in Baltimore-town : At whereas it has been reprefented that fuch record-office will not be built; therefore, BE IT ENACTED, That the faid fum of Money approfive hundred pounds shall be and is hereby appropriated to the building of the faid gaol, and that priated, &c. the commissioners mentioned in the aforefaid law shall and they are hereby directed to pay the faid. money to the commissioners mentioned in this act, to be applied by them to the purposes of this. act.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That feven of the justices of the peace of the faid county of Balti- Seven justices more shall be considered a fufficient number to constitute a levy court for the purposes of this act; sufficient, &c. and that the clerk of the faid court shall, and he is hereby directed, immediately after the passing of this act, to give notice to the justices of said county to meet for the purpose of imposing, and they are hereby directed to impole, on the affessable property of said county, agreeably to the provisions. of this act, the sum of sour thousand dollars, to be assessed and collected together with the tax laid. by the levy court of faid county at their last annual session.

WHEREAS the faid vestry have heretofore, to wit: in the years one thousand seven hundred Preamble. and eight, and one thousand seven hundred and nine, received deeds of certain lands in Talbot county, adjoining a tract of land called Jenning's Hope, and a tract of land called Goldiborough: And whereas doubts are entertained, whether, upon a true location thereof, faid lands, or part thereof, are not included in the lines of the land called Jenning's Hope, and of the land called Goldsborough, no part of which was conveyed to the faid vestry: And, whereas the faid vestry have prayed this general assembly that they may be authorised and empowered to receive a conveyance for, and to hold, the faid tracts of land called Jenning's Hope, and Goldsborough, or any part thereof, which the persons claiming the same may be willing to convey to the said vestry;

II. BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED, by, the General Affembly of Maryland, That the veftry of Saint- Veftry may re-Peter's parish, in Talbot county, elected, or hereafter to be elected, under an act, (a) entitled, An ceive a deed, act for the chablishment of felect vestries, and the acts supplementary thereto, be authorised and &c. empowered to receive a deed or deeds of gift, in the usual form of law, for the said tract or tracts of land called Jenning's Hope, and Goldiborough, or fuch part thereof as the person or persons claiming, the fame tract or tracts of lands may be disposed to convey to them; and that upon the execution of fuch deed or deeds, the faid vestry, and their successors, shall be seized and possessed of the lands fo conveyed, in as full and ample manner, and of the same estate, title or interest therein, in law or equity, as the donor or donors in faid deed or deeds may hold the same at the time of the execution of faid deed or deeds; and the faid lands shall, from thenceforth, be vested in the faid vestry, and their successors, in the same manner as the glebe-lands of said parish are or might be vested in them by virtue of the faid act, entitled, An act for the chablishment of select vestries, and the acts supplementary thereof.

An ACT to repeal an act, entitled, An act respecting the slaves of certain French subjects, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act of assembly, entitled, An act Anactrepealed, respecting the slaves of certain French subjects, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-two, * be and the fame is hereby repealed, faving nevertheless to all and every person . Chapter 36. and persons their several and respective rights acquired under the said act.
