C H A P. LXXVII.

An ACT to regulate the time of holding the orphans courts in Dorchester county, and to repeal part of the act of assembly therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 698.

C H A P. LXXVIII.

An ACT to empower the vestry of Shrewsbury parish, in Kent county, to sell the glebe-land belonging to the same. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 698.

Passed 20th of Jan. 1798.

WHEREAS the vestry of Shrewsbury parish, of Kent county, have petitioned this general assembly for a law empowering them to sell the glebe-land belonging to said parish, for the purpose of purchasing other land in a more convenient and advantageous situation, and also to enable said vestry to repair the church and chapel in said parish, which are in a ruinous condition; and have represented to this general assembly, that the said vestry possess no funds to defray the expence of repairing said church and chapel; therefore,

Preamble.

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the vestry of said parish be and they are hereby empowered to sell said glebe-land, and to apply such part of the money arising from the sale thereof as they deem proper to the purchase of other land for the use of said parish, and the surplus to the reparation of said church and chapel; provided nevertheless, that the said vestry give three months previous notice, by advertisements stuck up at the court-house door for said county, and one at each door of the church and chapel respectively, of the time and place of sale.

C H A P. LXXIX.

An ACT to make a temporary allowance to the judges of the court of appeals, in addition to their permanent salaries. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 699.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That each of the judges of the court of appeals shall be entitled to receive three hundred dollars, in addition to their permanent salaries fixed by law.

Additional allowance.

By 1799, ch. 52, each judge is to receive an annual salary of one thousand dollars, by quarterly payments.
