An ACT to empower the vestry of Shrewsbury parish, in Kent Passed 20th of Jan. 1798. county, to fell the glebe-land belonging to the same.

WHEREAS the vestry of Shrewsbury parish, of Kent county, have petitioned this general as- Preamble. sembly for a law empowering them to sell the glebe-land belonging to said parish, for the purpose of purchasing other land in a more convenient and advantageous situation, and also to enable faid vestry to repair the church and chapel in said parish, which are in a ruinous condition; and have represented to this general assembly, that the faid vestry possess no funds to defray the expence of repairing faid church and chapel; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the veftry of faid parish be and they Veftry may fell, are hereby empowered to fell faid glebe-land, and to apply fuch part of the money arifing from the &c. fale thereof as they deem proper to the purchase of other land for the use of said parish, and the surplus to the reparation of said church and chapel; provided nevertheless, that the said vestry give three months previous notice, by advertisements stuck up at the court-house door for faid county, and one at each deor of the church and chapel respectively, of the time and place of sale.

DE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That each of the judges of the court of ap- Additional alpeals shall be entitled to receive three hundred dellars in Additional alpeals shall be entitled to receive three hundred dollars, in addition to their permanent falaries lowance. fixed by law.

By 1799, ch. 52, each judge is to receive an annual falary of one thousand dollars, by quarterly payments.
