III. And BE IT ENACTED. That in all cases where the said register Francis King has made any C.H.A.P. fhort entry; thewing that any last will or testament; inventory or account, was proved by any person intertain cases or persons, or has lodged any last will or testament, inventory or account, among the records of his to enter a cerfaid office, it shall and may be lawful for the faid register, under the direction of the orphan's court tificate, &c. of the faid county, to enter thereon a certificate of fuch probat in the final form, and fuch certificate, formade, shall be, to all intents and purposes, as good and available as if the same had been done by the faid Francis King in his life-time.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid register, for his services in recording the faid wills, And entitled to inventories, probats and accounts, shall be entitled to the same fees as are now allowed by law in the same fees, like cases; and it shall and may be lawful for the said register to charge the person or persons, his, her or their legal representatives, with the same, to whom the same would properly have been chargeable by the faid Francis King, and the faid fees, fo charged, to put in the flierithis hands, to be collected as other officers fees.

WHEREAS Stephen Zacharie, by his petition to this general affembly, fets forth, that he is Preamble. confiderably indebted as a partner of Coopman and Vochez, trading under the firm of Zacharie, Coopman and company, and also in his private capacity, which debts he is unable to pay, but is willing and defirous to deliver up all his property to truffees, for the benefit of the creditors, and prayed an act might pass to exempt his person from arrest and imprisonment, on account of said debts: And whereas the creditors have agreed to the same, on certain terms and conditions agreed to by the faid Stephen Zacharie, and this general assembly are willing to carry into essect the agreement of the parties,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the faid Stephen Zacharie shall be S. Zacharie to empowered, and he is hereby required, to deliver possession of all his real and personal estate, of what nature and kind soever, unto Archibald Campbell, David Williamson, James Dall, John Munnickhuysen and Joseph Sterett, on or before the tenth day of March next, and to convey, assign and transfer, to them, all bonds, notes, books, accounts and other vouchers, of any and all sums of money, or other property, due and owing to the said Stephen Zacharie on his separate account, and to the firm of Zacharie, Coopman and company.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid Stephen Zacharie, at the time of delivering possession And make a of the faid real and personal estate to the said trustees, shall also make a schedule of the same, and ichedule, &c. deliver it to them, and make oath, to be annexed thereto, that the faid schedule contains a true account of all the real and personal estate, and debts due to him in his own right, and to the firm of Zacharie, Coopman and company, appearing by the books, papers and documents, of the faid Zacharie, Coopman and company, in the possession or knowledge of the faid Stephen Zacharie; and thereupon and from thenceforth, for the period and on the terms hereafter mentioned, the faid Stephen Zacharie shall be, and he is hereby acquitted, exonerated and discharged, of and from all claims and demands now due and owing from him, either in his separate capacity, or as a partner of the aforesaid Coopman and Vochez; provided, that any property hereaster acquired by the said Stephen Zacharie, by gift, devise, bequest, or in the course of distribution, shall be liable to the creditors.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That upon the affignment as aforefaid to the faid truftees, they, or Effate vefled, the survivor or survivors of them, Thall be and are hereby vested with the absolute estate and property of, in and to the same, in trust, for the benefit of the creditors, to be applied and disposed of to the payment and fatisfaction of the faid creditors, in equal proportion, according to the amount of their respective claims; and the said trustees, or the survivor or survivors of them, shall have sull power and authority to fell, convey and dispose of the same, or any part thereof, and to collect and receive the said debts due and owing to the said Stephen Zacharie, or to Zacharie, Coopman and company, or if need be, to bring fuit or fuits at law or equity in their own names, or in the name or names of the furvivor or furvivors of them.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in the execution of this truft, all reasonable or just expences Expences to be incurred or expended by the faid trustees, or the survivor or survivors of them, shall be paid out of paid, &c.
