C H A P. VII.

An ACT to authorise and empower the levy court of Montgomery county to assess and levy annually a sum of money for the support of Cassandra Thompson. Lib. JG. No. 3. fol. 22.

Preamble.

Justices to levy
money, &c.

WHEREAS Cassandra Thompson, of Montgomery county, by her petition to this general assembly hath set forth, that she is deprived of the use of her limbs by frequent attacks of the rheumatism, and has no other dependence whereby to subsist but on the benevolence and care of her affectionate brother, who is very poor, and prays an act may pass to provide for her future maintenance out of the poor's house; and the facts stated in said petition appearing to be true; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of Montgomery county shall be and are hereby directed and empowered, at their levy court annually, so long as they shall see cause, to assess and levy on the assessable property of said county a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the said Cassandra Thompson, and that the same be collected and paid annually by the collector of Montgomery county to such person as the levy court of said county shall or may direct.

C H A P. VIII.

An ACT to authorise and empower the justices of the levy court for Saint-Mary's county to assess and levy annually a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 3. fol. 22.

Preamble.

Justices to levy
money, &c.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, by the petition of Sarah Thompson, of Saint-Mary's county, that she is a poor woman, the mother of a dumb child about six years of age, and entirely deprived of the use of its limbs, and praying that a law may pass, authorising the justices of the levy court for Saint-Mary's county to levy a sum of money for the support of her said child; and the prayer of the petitioner appearing reasonable; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court for Saint-Mary's county be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to assess and levy annually, on said county, the sum of thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the child aforesaid, which shall be collected and paid by the collector or collectors of the county aforesaid to the said Sarah Thompson, or to any other person appointed guardian or trustee to the said child, agreeably to the order of the levy court aforesaid.

C H A P. IX.

An ACT to authorise and empower the levy court of Saint-Mary's county to assess and levy annually a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 3. fol. 23.

Preamble.

Justices to levy
money, &c.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, by the petition of Joseph Flower, that he is extremely poor, and is so unfortunate as to have a son seven years of age, dumb, and entirely deprived of his intellects, and praying that a law may pass for the support and maintenance of his said son out of the poor-house; and the prayer of the said petitioner appearing reasonable; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court for Saint-Mary's county be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to assess and levy annually, on said county, the sum of thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of James Flower, and to appoint Joseph Flower, or any other person, guardian or trustee to the said James Flower, to collect and receive the same agreeably to the order of the levy court aforesaid.

C H A P.
