C.H.A.P. HXXII

An ACT for the destruction of wolves in Frederick county.

[G. No. 3. tol. 45. HEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that wolves are very numerous and miss. Preamble. Vischievous in the county aforesaid, and that they destroy a great number of sheep; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That when and as often as any free Juffice to give a person or persons shall bring before any justice of the peace for Frederick county the head or heads of certificate, &c. any wolf or wolves, and make oath, or affirmation if a quaker, menonilt or tunker, that the wolf or wolves of which he or they produce the head or heads were actually caught and killed within the limits of Frederick county within fix days next before the producing of the same to such justice, that then fuch jultice shall and he is hereby authorised and directed to give such person or persons producing the same a certificate for such head or heads produced and proved as aforesaid, and in such certificate to mention the oath or affirmation taken, and therein diftinguish how many of the heads are of old or young wolves; and every justice who shall have any wolves head or heads brought before him by any person or persons as aforesaid, shall be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to judge of the age of the faid wolf or wolves of which the faid-head or heads was brought before him, and if fuch juffice shall believe the age of such wolf or wolves to exceed fix months, that then he shall diffinguish it in his certificate by the words Old Wolf or Wolves, but if he shall believe the said wolf or wolves to be under the age of fix months, that then he shall distinguish the same in his certificate by the words Young Wolf or Wolves, and that every justice before whom any wolf's head is brought, and by whom a certificate shall be given as aforefaid, is hereby authorised and directed immediately to cause the ears to be cut off, and the tongue to be taken out of and from the head or heads of fuch wolf or wolves, to prevent fuch head or heads from being a second time carried before a justice in order to obtain a certificate.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That every person or persons who shall produce a certificate as afore. To be allowed, faid to the justices of Frederick county at the levy court shall, for every old wolf's head be allowed &c. fixteen dollars, and for every young wolf's head be allowed eight dollars, to be by the faid justices affelfed and levied in the county levy, together with the theriff's or collector's commission for collecting the same, and to be paid by the sheriff or collector to such person or persons as shall be entitled to the fame as aforefaid, any thing in any other law to the contrary notwithstanding.

IV. This act to continue and be in force for four years, and to the end of the next fession of as- Duration. fembly which shall happen thereafter.

C H A P. XXIII.

An ACT for the relief of Philemon Dorsey, of Anne-Arundel county, a lunatic. Lib. JG. No. 3. fol. 46.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that the annual proceeds of the personal Preamble. cestate of the said Philemon Dorsey is by no means sufficient for his support, and that he is feized in fee of two parcels of land, fituate in Anne-Arundel county, which are totally unproductive, the one not being improved, and the other subject to the life estate of his mother, and that if the fame, or part thereof, were fold on a credit, and the proceeds loaned out on interest, for the use of the faid lunatic, that the fame would be amply sufficient for his support and maintenance; and it appearing reasonable the real estate of the said lunatic should be applied to his support,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the chancellor for the time being Chancellor to shall have power and authority, upon application of any person on the part of said Philemon Dorsey, orderasale, &c. and being satisfied that it is necessary for the support and maintenance of said Philemon Dorsey, to order the whole, or such part of the real estate of said Philemon Dorsey as he may think necessary, to be fold for the purpole aforefaid, upon such terms as he may think proper, and to appoint a trustee or trustees for the purpose of effecting such sale or sales.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That all fales made by the authority of the chancellor under this act, To be confirme shall be notified to, and confirmed by, the chancellor, before any conveyance of the property shall ed by him, &c. be made; and bond, with good and fufficient fecurity, to be approved by the chancellor, shall be given by the person or persons empowered to fell the property as aforesaid, for the due execution of the trust committed, which bond shall be lodged with the register in chancery.
