nies remaining unexpended in their hands, togother with the books of account, of the corporation; and all notes, bonds, and other evidences of debt thereunto belonging, or in anywife appertaining.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid corporation shall be able and capable hereafter to purchase, receive, hold and enjoy, any estate, real, personal or mixed, not exceeding fix thousand dollars.

WHEREAS Philip Edwards, of Baltimore county, has flated to this general affembly his in- Preamble. ability to pay his debts, and has petitioned for an act to release him therefrom upon giving up all his property to the use of his creditors: And whereas the said Philip Edwards, being an officer in the navy of the United States, is diable, from the military arrangements, to be called out of this state, which justifies a distinction of his case from others who have petitioned for similar

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That in case the said Philip Edwards Oath to be shall, before some justice of the peace for the county where he resides, make and subscribe the taken, &c. following oath, to wit: " I, Philip Edwards, do swear, or assirm, that I will deliver up, con-" vey and transfer, to the use of my creditors, all my property, real, personal or mixed, (the neces-" fary wearing apparel of myself and family, as allowed by my trustee, only excepted,) that I have or claim any title to, or interest in, at this time, and all debts, rights and claims, which I have " at this time, or that I am in any respect entitled to, in possession, remainder or reversion; and that " I have not, directly or indirectly, at any time before, fold, conveyed, leafed, disposed of, or in-" trulted or concealed, any part of my property of any kind, or any part of my debts, rights or " claims, thereby wilfully to defraud or deceive my creditors, or any of them, or to fecure the fame, " or to receive or expect any profit, benefit or advantage thereby;" and shall execute and acknowledge, before two justices of the same county, a deed to his trustee, appointed in virtue of this act, on behalf of his creditors, for all his property, debts, rights and claims, agreeably to his faid oath, in trust for his creditors, a schedule whereof he shall insert in, or annex to, the said deed, that thereupon, and for ever thereafter, the faid Philip Edwards shall, by virtue of this act, be acquitted, released, and for ever discharged, from all debts, promises, contracts, agreements and covenants, due from, or contracted, made or entered into by him, before the paffing this act; provided, that any property acquired by the faid Philip Edwards, after the making the faid deed, by descent, or in his own right by devise, bequest, or in course of distribution, shall be liable for the payment of his debts.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the sheriff of Baltimore county shall be and is hereby appoint- Sheriff aped as truftee in behalf of the creditors of the faid Philip Edwards; and the faid sheriff, before pointed trustee, he acts as fuch, shall take the following oath before some justice of the peace of said county, to wit: " I. A. B. do swear, that I will faithfully, impartially and honeftly, according to the best of my 6 fkill and knowledge, execute the feveral powers and trufts repoled in me as truftee for the credi-46 tors of Philip Edwards, without favour, affection, prejudice or malice."

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if the faid Philip Edwards shall be arrested or imprisoned If arrested, to on any process sued out on any judgment or decree obtained against him for any debt, damages or be discharged, colts, contracted, owing, or growing due before the palling of this act, the court out of which fuch process issued shall and may discharge the faid Philip Edwards on motion; and if the said Philip Edwards shall be arrested or imprisoned on any process for the recovery of any debt, damages or colls, contracted, owing, or growing due before the passing of this act, the court before whom such process shall be returned shall and may discharge the faid Philip Edwards out of custody on his common appearance being entered, without any special bail; provided, that the discharge of the faid Philip Edwards shall not acquit any other person from such debt, damages or costs, or any part thereof, but that all fuch persons shall be answerable for the same in such manner as they were before the palling of this act.

V.
