CHAP. LI.

An ACT to prevent the going at large of geese and swine in the town Passed 15th of of Havre-de-Grace, in Harford county. Lib. JG. No. 3. fol. 110.

BE ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland; That from and after the first day of April, No geele, &c. in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and hinety-nine, no geese or swine belong to go at large, ing to the inhabitants of said town shall be suffered to go at large in the town of Havre-de-Grace, &c. in Harford county; and if any person shall find any geese or swine going at large in the town of -Havre de-Grace aforesaid, it shall and may be lawful for such person to kill, or cause to be killed, fuch geefe or fwine.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED, 'That if any person shall be sued for killing any swine or geese going at General issue large in the town of Havre de-Grace aforesaid, such person may plead the general issue, and give pleadable, &c. this act and the special matter in evidence.

C H A P. LII.

An ACT to prevent the going at large of swine within three miles of George-town, in Montgomery county. Lib. JG. No. 3. fol. 110.

BEIT ENACTED, by the General Ajembly of Maryland, That from and after the first day of March, Swine not to in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, no swine shall be suffered to go at 80 at large, &c. large in that part of Montgomery county lying between Patowmack river and Rock creek, and within three miles of George-town; and if any person shall find on his land, or on any land in his possession lying within three miles of the said town, and between the said river and creek, any swine, it shall and may be lawful for him any such swine to impound, or cause to be impounded.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of every person who shall impound any swine Is impounded, in virtue of this law, to cause the marks and description of such swine to be advertised in the to be adver-George-town news-paper for at least feven days, and if the same are not reclaimed by that time, and tiled, &c. the expences of advertifing, impounding and keeping them, paid, that the same shall be publicly fold, giving feven days notice of the time and place, and the proceeds of fuch fale shall be first applied to the expense of advertising, impounding and keeping them, and the surplus to the owner of faid swine, if demanded within fixty days after the sale, and if not demanded within that time, then fuch furplus to be paid to the trustees of the poor-house for Montgomery county.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any person shall be sued for impounding any swine found upon General issue his land, or any land in his possession, the defendant may plead the general issue, and give this act pleadable, &c. and the special matter in evidence.

C H A P. LIII.

A Further supplement to the act, (a) entitled, An act to lay out several turnpike roads in Baltimore county, and for other purposes. Lib. JG. No. 3. fol. 111.

WHEREAS the commissioners of review for Baltimore county have not, in conformity to the Preamble. VV powers vested in them by an act * of the last general assembly, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to lay out several turnpike roads in Baltimore county, and for other purposes, within the time therein limitted, reviewed, and ultimately ascertained, the direction of the several turnpike roads mentioned in said further supplement; therefore,

II. BE IT. ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the time limitted in the faid further Timcextended. Supplement, passed at the last fession of assembly, for ascertaining and fixing the direction of the turnpike roads therein mentioned, be and the same is hereby extended to the first Monday in October next.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid commissioners of review, (provided it is not sooner Commissioners, done,) shall meet in the city of Baltimore on the first Monday in may next, and from thence proceed to meet, &c. to review, and ultimately afcertain, the direction of all the roads which they are authorifed to review and afcertain, and if a majority of the faid commissioners of review shall not attenu agreea-Kkkkk 2
