WHERE AS William Dent Beall, of Montgomery county, has flated to this general affembly, Preamble. has petitioned for amachito releafe him therefrom upon giving up all his property to the ule of his creditors . And whereas the faid William Dent Beall, being a major in the fervice of the United States, is liable, from the military arrangements, to be called out of this state, which justifies a diftinction of his cafe from others who have petitioned for limitar acts;

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That in case the said William Dent Beall On making shall, before the associate justices of Montgomery county court, make and subscribe the following oath, &c. acouth, to wit: "I, William Dent Beall, do swear, that I will deliver up, convey and transfer, to quitted, &c. " the use of my creditora, all my property, real, personal or mixed, (the necessary wearing apparel " of mylelf and family only excepted,) that, I have or claim any title to, or interest ing at this time, " and all debts, rights and claims, which I have at this time, or that I am in any respect entitled " to, in possession, remainder or reversion, and that I have not, directly or indirectly, at any time " before, fold, conveyed, leafed, disposed of, or intrusted or concealed, any part of my property of " any kind, or any part of my debts, rights or claims, thereby wilfully to defraud or deceive my " creditors, or any of them, or to secure the same, or to receive or expect any profit, benefit or " advantage thereby;" and shall execute and acknowledge, before the aforesaid associate justices, a conveyance to fuch person as the faid associate justices may appoint as his trustee, on behalf of his creditors, of all his property as aforefaid, a schedule whereof he shall infert in or annex to the faid conveyance, that thereupon, and for ever thereafter, the faid William Dent Beall shall, by virtue of this act, be acquitted, released, and for ever discharged, from all debts, promises, contracts, agreements and covenants, due from, or contracted, made or entered into by him, before the passing this act; provided, that any property acquired by the faid William Dent Beall, after the making the faid conveyance, by descent, or in his own right by devise, bequest, or in the course of distribution; shall be liable for the payment of his debts: Arry bug object participation

III. AND BE IT ENACTED. That the person appointed in pursuance of this act as trustee in behalf Trustee to take of the creditors of the faid William Dent Beall, before he acts as fuch, shall take the following oath, an oath, &c. before one of the faid affociate justices, to wit: " I, A. B. do swear, that I will faithfully, impar-" tially and honeftly, according to the best of my skill and knowledge, execute the several powers 44 and trusts reposed in me as trustee for the creditors of William Dent Beall, without favour, affection, prejudice or malice;" and shall also give bond for the faithful performance of his duty, to fuch person, in trust for the creditors of faid William Dent Beall, and in such penalty as the said affociate julijees finil direct, which shall be recorded in the clerk's office of Montgomery county, and a copy thereof, certified under the hand of the faid clerk, shall be good evidence in any court of law or equity of this state.
