Arundel county, that they labour under great inconveniencies for want of a road from the widow Robinson's, to lead through the lands of Thomas Chaney, Randall and Dobbin, and of Mrs. Pumphrey, till it interfects the public road leading from Baltimore town to the Magothy mountains, and also for want of one other road from the said widow Robinson's, running by Waters's mill, and through the lands of Benjamin Gambrill, till it interfects the mountain road leading to Patapico ferry; and this general affembly thinking the prayer thereof reasonable, therefore,

H. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That Richard Cromwell, Dorsey Jacob Commissioners and Richard Merriken, or any two of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, to appointed, &c. furvey; lay out and open, a road, not exceeding thirty feet wide, in fuch direction as the fituation of the ground will admit, from the widow Robinson's, leading through the lands of Thomas Chaney, Randall and Dobbin, and Mrs. Pumphrey, till it interfects the public road leading from Baltimoretown to the Magothy mountains, and to lay out and open a road from the said widow Robinson's, leading by Waters's mill, and so through Benjamin Gambrill's land, till it intersects the mountain road leading to Patapico ferry; and the faid roads, so surveyed, laid out and opened, and the valuation herein after directed to be made shall have taken place, and the expences of surveying, laying out and opening, faid roads, and the amount of valuation, shall have been paid by the parties therein interested; shall be recorded in Anne-Arundel county land records, and shall be deemed and taken to be public roads for ever thereafter, and kept up, amended and repaired, as all other public roads in faid county are kept in repair.

III. And BE IT ENACTED, That the faid commissioners shall ascertain and value what damages Damages to be may be sustained by any person or persons through whose lands the said roads shall pass; provided al- ascertained, &c. ways, that if any person or persons through whose lands the said roads shall pass, or his, her or their guardians or truftee, shall conceive themselves aggrieved by such valuation and assessment of damages by the faid commissioners, it shall and may be lawful for said commissioners, or any two of them, to issue their warrant to the sheriff of the county, commanding him to summon twelve good and lawful men of the county, not interested in the premises, and qualified to serve as jurors in the county court, to appear to day by them to be appointed on the premises; and the said commission oners are hereby afthorifed to administer an oath to every person so summoned, that he will, without favour, affection, prejudice or partiality, affels the damages at whole request such inquisition shall be taken, by realog if opening the aforesaid roads through his, her or their land; and the perions fo fummoned and form shall thereupon proceed to assess and value the damages accordingly, and fuch inquifition shall be final and conclusive between the parties.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid commissioners shall not lay out or open the faid roads Not to go thro' through the buildings, gardens, orchards or meadows, of any person without his or her consent.
