

ROADS.

Overseers of the roads excepted from the description of officers to be appointed by the governor and council. Const. 48.

The privilege of roads and waters reserved to the public through all the reserved lands westward of Fort Cumberland therein disposed of. November, 1788, ch. 44, § 14.
