1. Inprimis that the said Treasurer and Receiver generall from
time to time make diligent Enquiry and take particular
Notice of all rents Customs and arrears fines felons
goods deadands Wrecks Waifes and Strayes and all
other goods and Chattells perquisites and profits from time
to time belonging to his Lopp in the said Province of Mary
land and Enter them in a Register Booke to be kept
by him for that purpose and take care in due time by
himselfe or his sufficient Deputy or Deputies for whom
he is to be responsible to demand recover and receive
