

6 - Item that out of all the rents Customs fines forfeitures and
other profits aforesaid which shall be recovered and received by
him for his Lopp use and that shall clearly belong unto his
Lopp over and above the said Receivers salary he first deliver
yearly one third part thereof to his Lopp Lieutenant of the said
Province or to whom he shall appoint for his the said
Lieutenants own use as the salary allowed him by his
Lopp And that then he doe dispose of the residue as his
Lopp or his said Lieut and Secret shall appoint accord-
ing to such directions, as his Lopp shall from time to
time give them for that purpose And that the said Receiver
generall give his Lopp an account thereof yearly by the
first opportunity which he shall have and before
yeare at Com^{ing} the 10th Day of November in the
yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred fifty
and five -

the said office and employment Know ye that we doe
hereby discharge him the said Henry Coursey of and from
the
