 oppose you in it you are to maintain his Lordships Rights there  
 by force if need be which his Lordship will Justifie you in It  
 is likewise his Lordships further pleasure that the Surveyor  
 Generall do set out for his Lordship at the Whore hill and  
 Sea Board side of the Eastern shore of the best Land and in the  
 most convenient places to be found in these parts two manors  
 in every County each manor containing six thousand acres at least

Whoreas his Lordship granted to his son a power

 person of the privy Council and other officers and to add to the number  
 of the said privy Council such persons as he thought fit his Lordship

 out special Warrant for the same under his Lordships hand
