9. And whereas for the better Collection of the severall Rates and Dutyes Imposed by the said Act of the 25th year of the late King's Reigne, that whole Businesse is to be ordered and managed, and the severall Dutyes thereby imposed are to be caused to be Levied by the Commissioners of Our Customs in England for the time being by and under the authority and direction of Our Treasurer or Commissioners of Our Treasury for the time being, you are forthwith to require and command such of your Officers as have taken upon them the Collection of the said Rates and Dutyes to cease any further to Act therein, and to render to the said Commissioners of Our Customs an Account of their Receipts and Payments since the death of the late Collector, together with an account of their Seizures and other proceedings; And you are to
