And Whereas by a Clause in the aforesaid
Act of Frauds, no Foreign Built Ship, that
is to say, not Built in any of Our Dominion
of Asia Africa or America, or other than
such as shall bona fide have been bought
before the first of Octob. 1662, and Expressly
named in the List thereby appointed to be
made of all Foreign Built Ships in all the
Ports of England, shall Enjoy the Privileges
a Ship belonging to England or Ireland, altho
owned or Manned by English (Except such
Ships only as shall be taken at Sea by
of War or Reprisal, and Condemnation
thereof made in the Court of Admiralty at
lawfull Price) but all such Ships shall be
deemed as Aliens Ships, And be liable to all
Duties that Aliens Ships are liable to by Virtue
of
