

Of the aforesaid Act for the Encouraging
and Encouraging of Shipping & Navigation;
and Whereas by a Clause in the aforesaid Act
for preventing Frauds & Regulating Houses
in the Plantation Trade, It is Enacted that -
after the 25th of March 1698. No Goods or
Merchandise whatsoever shall be Imported
into or Exported out of any of Our Colonies or
Plantations in Asia, Africa, or America, or
shall be Laden in or Carried from any one
of the said Colonies or plantations to any other Port or place in
any Port or place in the same, Our Kingdom
of England, Dominion of Wales or Towns
of Berwick upon Tweed, in any Ship or
Bottom, but what is or shall be of the built
of England or Ireland, or of the said Colonies
or Plantations, and wholly Owned by the
people thereof or any of them, and Navigated
wth the Master and threefourth of the Marin.
of the said places only, Except such Ships -
only as shall be taken Prize & Condemnation
Thereof
