

As well by the Acts made in
the 12th & 25th Years of the Reign of His late
Majesty King Charles 2^d. The former -
Entituled, An Act for the Encouraging and
Increasing of Shipping and Navigation;
And the latter Entituled An Act for the
Encouragement of the Greenland and Eastland
Trades, and for the better Securing the Plantation
Trades, Certain Commodities therein Enumerated
of the Growth production or Manufacture
of any of the English plantations in
America, Asia or Africa, are Obliged to be
Imported, into the Kingdom of England,
Dominion of Wales or Town of Berwick
upon Tweed, or to some other of the said
Plantations under the Securities and
Penalties in the said Acts particularly
mentioned, so the said this Kingdome might
be made a Staple not only of the Commodities
of those plantations, but also of Commodities
of
