5^{thly} Whereas the Justices of several County Courts have taken
upon them to agree for certain Rates with Persons for keeping Ferrys
over several of the Rivers within my Province for the Inhabitants of these
several Counties, and to assess these Rates upon the Inhabitants without
any Law to warrant such Assessment which practice is not only an
Invasion of our Right, But an Injury to the People who are assessed con-
trary to Law, You are therefore hereby directed to take proper Measures
to put a Stop to such illegal Practices, and to take all necessary Care that
neither our Right or Property be Invaaded or the people imposed on
in that particular —

6^{thly} When you Resign your Office which is at your own
Request you will be pleased to Deliver all Instructions and other Papers
Relative to my Affairs to your Successor, and I hope you will give
Such other Lights as you shall Judge for my Service.
