As to the Ferrys I would have my Agent Sell them upon Leases of three years only, and if they were Sell to the County Courts It is my Opinion it would Contribute to the Ease of the People, and I would have all those who Sell up Ferrys in Opposition to those Leases entirely Discourtenanced by all the Magistrates in the Province.

8th

It is my Desire also that my Agent impower the Sheriffs to take up all Waifs Strays Deadends &c. And to allow them Good Commission for their Encouragement and by this Method it is to be hoped my Interest will not only be Advanaced, But the people likewise Rendered much Securer than if the Rangers were to Continue as usual many of them having proved Legall Thieves
