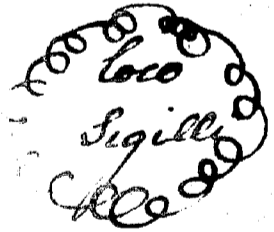


INSTRUCTIONS to Benjamin Taster Esq. our Agent

WHEREAS by my last Instructions of the 26<sup>th</sup> of May  
you were Ordered to pay to the Generall Rent Roll keepers five  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent.  
it never was my Intention to allow them more than five  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent on what  
came Heat into your hands,  $\frac{1}{2}$  p<sup>ts</sup> under Our hand and Seal at London  
this 2<sup>d</sup> Day of August. 1735
