Baltimore You shall not for the future allow the Collectors of the Revenue their Deductions till they produce you fair Copies of their Respective Rent Rolls, with the Non payments, and such other Animadversions as you shall direct to be inserted therein.

2 You shall not allow the General Rent Roll keepers their Perquisites Salaries or Deductions, till you shall be Satisfied they have made the Alterations in the Said General Rent Rolls, Necessary to be made every Year, according to the Alienations, and such other Entries as you shall think convenient to be made.

3 You shall direct the Collectors of the Rent to demand an Alienation fine on the Death of the Possors of all Land, as you will find it is the Opinion of the Lawyers here, (brought by Mr. Jennings) Sam. Intitled to

4 You shall take no Foreign Gold at above three pounds sixteen Shillings and Nine pence, and Silver at five Shillings per Ounce; that being the price it Bears here Given under Our hand and Seal at London this 15th Day of December 1735
