You will here with receive my Dissents to the following Acts of Assembly to be published & Entered on Record according to your Forms viz.

Whereas at a Sessions of Assembly begun & held in our Province of Maryland the 3^d Day of October, & Ending the 2^d day of Nov^r in the 14th year of our Dominion over the said Province anno^q Domⁱ: 1728. these Acts were passed viz. an Act for ascertaining the Form of the Oath of Judge or Justice. also an Act for Improving the Staple of Tobacco. and a Supplementary Act, Intituled an Act, for the Establishm^t. of Religious Worship in this Province according to the Church of England, & for the Maintenance of Ministers

And Whereas at a Sessions of Assembly begun & held in our s^d Province of Maryland the 10th of July, & ending the 8th of Aug^t in the 15th year of our Dominion over the s^d Province anno^q Domⁱ: 1729. — An Act concerning the Parishes in St. Mary's & Charles Counties. Also an Act Reviving & continuing an Act, to restrain the ill Practices of Attornys, & to prevent their taking Money Fees; & ascertaining what Fees shall be allowed to the Practitioners of the Law who shall attend the Circuit Courts.
