5. Whereas by my Instructions of 4th 19th of
last August, on Article of Tonnage & Measurement of
Ships trading to our parts, & tho' the Custom of
Registering of Ships, w^{ch} said Register all Vessels are
cleared without any Measurement, or at least at
much less, than they are, w^{ch} is become so great an
apparent abuse, that I will not suffer to be thus treated
for the future, & tho' Custom may be pleaded, yet it
shall not be a Bar to Equity; Therefore I do require
Direct you to give positive Orders to all my Naval
Officers not to suffer any Vessel to clear her
Loading, unless she first pays her Tonnage according
to her Measurement.

6. You are hereby directed to tell the Executors
of Jam^s. Carroll that as to the Acc^t. deliver'd ag^t.
Me, whereby the Balance on their Side is made
72000^l of Tobacco, of w^{ch} they demand payment
you are to signify to them, y^t I shall not order
any paym^t. knowing of no agreem^t. that has
made with Mr. James Carroll for keeping my
Rent Rolls.
