Additional Orders & Instructions to our  
Agent Math: Til<sup>d</sup> Ward Esq<sup>r</sup>

1. In all Things relative to your Office, You shall <sup>act</sup> by <sup>eye</sup> with the Advice & Consent of the Chancellor for the time being who is directed to be Assistant to you & to sign with you jointly all papers necessary.
2. You shall endeavour with the Chancellor to Lett any of my Mannors & appoint such Officers in them as you & He shall judge most for my service.
3. You shall be very exact in Methodizing y<sup>r</sup> Acc<sup>t</sup>. & making those under y<sup>r</sup> direction Acc<sup>t</sup>. with you half yearly.
4. You shall cause all the Rents of my Leases for Lands Herrys &c. to be paid you in Sterling.
5. When you resign y<sup>r</sup> Office, wh<sup>ch</sup> is at y<sup>r</sup> own Request, you will be pleased to deliver all Instructions
