1. 'Tis my Pleasure that my Agent demand Sterling of such
Patentees, several others in the like circumstances having
considerd the Matter, as it really is, a Mistake, & no other,
have honestly paid all the Rent due; & in case of non-
compliance the Atty. Gen^r. has orders to proceed in
Chancery against them.

As the getting all the Rent. Rolls fully & perfectly
Completed, would be of the greatest Service both to Me &
my posterity, there is nothing w^{ch}. I more recomend to my
Agent's care, than to forward it as much as possible, in
6. order hereunto, I would have you oblige the Farmers of the
Quit-Rents to return you annually one Rent Roll-Book of
every particular County each Farmer Rents, & a Copy of
Books must be transmitted yearly to England.

As to the Ferys, I would have my Agent let them
upon Leases of 3 years only, & if they were let to the
County-Courts 'tis my opinion it would contribute to the
7. Ease of y^e. people, and I would have all those who set up
Ferys in opposition to these Leases, entirely discourag'd
by all the Magistrates of the Province.

'Tis my Desire that my Agent Impower y^e. Sheriffs
take up all Waifs, Strays, Deadlands &c. & to allow
them good Compensation for their Encouragement; & by this
8. Method it is to be hoped my Interest will not only be
advanced, but the people likewise be rendered much
secured, than if the Bangers were to continue as usual,
many of them having prov'd legal-Thieves.
