

You shall not allow the gen<sup>e</sup> Rent-Roll Keepers their Perquisites Sallerys or Deductions, till you shall be satisfy'd they have made the alterations in the 1<sup>st</sup> gen<sup>e</sup> Rent-Roles necessary to be made every year according to the alterations, & such other Entries as you shall think convenient to be made.

3. You shall direct the Collectors of the Kent, to Demand an Alienation Fine on the Death of the possessors of all Land; as you will find in the Opinion of the Lawyers here I am Intituled to, brought by Mr. Jennings.

A You shall not take foreign-Gold at above £3:14:6 p<sup>r</sup> ounce, & silver at 5s, that being the price it bears here.
