 Province of Maryland Annoq^o Domini 1742 an Act
 Intituled an Act to Divide Somerset County & to erect
 a new County called Worcester passed into a Law on
 Due Consideration thereof We have thought fit
 to Dissent to said Act and do hereby declare said
 Act Null, Void, and of no Effect
