Additional Orders & Instructions to our dearly Beloved
Tho. Bladen Esq. Our Lieutenant Governour of Our
Province of Maryland

Whereas diverse Complaints have
been made to me of the many hardships & delays that
my Good Tenants have been Subject to by reason
of the Practices of the County Clerks, and Under
Officers Appointed by the Commissary to several Counties
for Remedy Whereof I doe direct & require of you
that no such Officers be for future appointed without
your Privy or Consent, Or of Governour for time being
and to be removed at Pleasure, & of this Our Instruction
you are to acquaint the Secretary of Commissary and
to take Care it be Complied with

2^{dly} You are to suffer no Law relating to
Paper Currency to pass without sending said Law
Over first for my perusal, it being absolutely
necessary for the Trade of his Majesty's Subjects here
to Consult wth them on that Head

You are to Cause these our Instructions
to be Entered in the Journalls of Our the Counsell

Given Under Our hand and Seal
at London this Twenty eighth day of Decem^r
in the Twenty ninth Year of our Dominion over
said Province Anno^o Domini 1763
