 Expectation, it should at any time be pass'd
 otherwise, you are at all events to take care
 that your said bills do not pass, And as for
 any Law that may be for the Health, Happiness
 & prosperity of the Province, no Body shall
 ever be readier to come into it than my
 self, as every such Law, much of course
 tend to my own Interest & that of my
 Tenants
