And in order that you may not meet with any obstruction therein, we have by this conveyance sent to Samuel Ogle Esq: His Lordship's Lieutenant Governor in and over the said Province, proper orders and instructions Powers and authorities, for him, to require, that all offices and officers in the said Province do aid and assist you therein, and also the every act on their parts required; And that the said Lieutenant Governor should him self likewise Aid and Assist you in these matters where his Aid and Assistance should be found necessary. You will therefore be careful to comply with what the said Secretarys Letter does require, and make your Returns to him from time to time as you proceed for the speediest knowledge of these matters; as the same will be very acceptable to us, and his Lordship.
