8th... If any Emergen^{cy} of Government shall arise not provided for by these Our Instructions You are to act therein according to your best Discretion with the opinion and advice nevertheless of the Council for the time being, Transmitting to us the earliest account of such Your Proceedings.

9th... You are to cause these Our Instructions to be forthwith entered on the Council Books of the said Province.

Given at London this 20th day of June 1751. in the first year of the Dominion of the said Frederick Lord Baltimore Anno Dom: 1751. under the hands and seals of the said Arthur Onslow and John Sharpe with the approbation of the said Frederick Lord Baltimore testified under his Hand and Seal hereunto sett.
