Boundary of Maryland.

in Council.

The humble Petition of the Right Honourable
Arthur Onslow Esq^r Speaker of the House of
Commons and one of His Majesty's most Honourable
Privy Council and of John Sharpe of Lincoln Inn
Esq^r the Guardians of the Person and Estates of the
Right Honourable Frederick Lord Baltimore Lord
Proprietary of the Province of Maryland in America,
an Infant under the age of Twenty one Years

Sheweth

That His Majesty King Charles the First by
His Royal Charter or Letters Patent under the great Seal of
England bearing date the 20th of June in the 5th Year of his
Reign gave and granted to Cecilius then Baron of Baltimore
and his Heirs a large Tract of Land in America comprehended under
the General Denomination of Maryland with the following Bound-
aries and Description. viz^t.

"All that Part of a Peninsula lying in the Parts of America
"between the Ocean on the East and the Bay of Chesapeake on
"the West and divided from the other part thereof by a Right line
"drawn from the Promontory or Cape of Land called Waterhous
"Point situate in the a fore said Bay near the River wigheo on the
West
