

For Talbot County. Thomas Hoffmann is mentioned as the Receiver, and in the Entry of whose Account $17/4$ is charged for a Rent not in the Roll, & $6/$ for Commission at $10/$ Cent without mentioning on what sum, and credit is taken for $14/5/2$ & $13/6/2$ for Lands paid for by Grady Pemberton to the Receiver of Queen Anns County; of which Receivers account there is no Entry to prove the said payments by; Nor how the balance of the Quit Rents in Queen Anns County as enter'd in the abstract appears to be $£ 290. 16. 0.$ the balance received of Edward Filghman the Receiver thereof.

For Kent County. Jacob Jones is mentioned as the Farmer, and in the Entry of his account, the amount of the Years Quit Rents do not appear, only the balance debitted therein; whereby the Commission he has paid him self thereout for receiving the same does not appear; which is very particular: As the Commission taken by all the other several Farmers & Receivers do appear in each of their accounts which have been Enter'd.

For Cecil County. Alexander Baird is mentioned as the Receiver, and in the Entry of whose account, the charge of 9. articles amounting amounting to $£ 11. 10. 6/2$ are over added $1/2$ & $10/10/2$ is charged for commission without mentioning on what sum & at what what rates, and in the credit part $9/2/2$ is charged for Commission on $£ 4. 12. 0.$ at $10/$ Cent which amounts only to $9/2/4$.
