Your Letters of the 13.th & 23.^d of June last I have received wherein were inclosed your memorandum with the Copy of Dr. Brookess's Letter to the Representatives of Calvert County, and his Memorial said to have been laid before the Earl of Halifax; and the Papers authenticated for Evidence, with others from you, to prove the falsehood, Inconsistency, and contradictions of his unjust calumny, so highly injurious and levell'd at the late Lord Proprietary and in respect to the conduct of two of his Governors, Mr. Bladen & the late Mr. Ogle; also the Council of state & Judge under their administration of Government and during the time of their residence in the Province of Maryland.
