Extract of the Report of the Board of Trade to the
Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury dated
28. February 17th 50. upon the Account of Expences in-
-curred in the Northern Colonies on the intended Expedition
against Canada, with respect to the Arms furnished
the men raised in this Province (Maryland) we must acquaint
your Lordship that it appears from an Address of the House
of Delegates of that Province to their Governor, a Copy whereof
is annexed that no Arms were to be purchased there,
whereupon in order to prevent any Lett to the Expedition, the
Quantity of 300. musquets, with Slings and Bayonets 300. Carbouch
Types with Belts, 6. Drums, 9. Half Pistols and 6. Halberts, were by
the Consent of the House supplied out of the Publick Cha-
-ge of the said Province, on Condition of their being
replaced for the use of the Publick which in the said
Address they desire may be done but the said Arms
have not been returned.
