1. You are to communicate forthwith to  
our Council of State in Maryland, such and so many  
of these our Instructions, wherein their Advice and  
Consent is mentioned to be requisite, as likewise all  
such others from time to time, as you shall find con-  
venient for our Service to be imparted to them.

2. You are to permit the Members of our said  
Council, to have and enjoy Freedom of Debate, and Vote  
in all Affairs of Publick concern that may be debated  
in Council.

3. And although any three of our Councillors  
make a Quorum, it is nevertheless my will and Measure  
that you do not act with a Quorum of less than five  
members of our said Council; unless upon extraordinary Emergencies  
when a greater Number cannot conveniently be had.
