to prevent cropping cutting or defacing Tobacco taken  
on board Ships or Vessels upon Freight, and for laying  
Impositions on Tobacco per the Hogshead for the support  
of Government &c: whether there should be any allowance  
and permission given to ship any quantities of Tobacco free  
from the Country Duties in lieu of the like quantities  
taken by the Enemy in time of War or by Pirates, You are  
permitted to give Your consent to any Bill that may be  
passed which is proper for clearing up such Doubt; But  
you will take care to do this in such a manner as to shew  
your compliance herein to be an act of Favour and not  
of Right, since it lessens the Revenue arising to the  
Support of Government from Duties on Tobaccos.

12. Whereas it may not only not be necessary,  
but perhaps improper considering the few Persons there  
are in Maryland properly qualified for the due Administra-  
tion of Justice, to have so many Justices in our Provincial  
Court as usually have been heretofore; And whereas  
the Lessening their number will tend to lessen the Publick  
charge of the Province. You are therefore to take into  
your consideration whether it may not be proper to reduce  
and Limit the Number of such Provincial Justices to Five  
or Six. And in case such alteration shall be by you thought  
proper to be made, You are first to inform me thereof be-  
fore you take any steps herein in order to have my  
previous approbation thereof.

13. You are to take care that in all Penal Parts of  
Law, the Fines be applyed to the support of Government as  
usual.
