

24.) You are to take care, that in all Acts or orders to be passed within our said Province in any Case for Levying money or imposing Fines and Penalties, express mention be made that the same is granted or Reserved to me and my Heirs for the publick uses of our said Province and the Support of the Government thereof as by the said act or order shall be directed.

25.) You shall take care that the Members of the Assembly be Elected only by Freeholders as being most agreeable to the Custom of Great Britain, to which you are as near as may be to conform your self.

26.) And whereas by an Act passed in the Assembly of Maryland the 21.th of September 1709. Entituled an Act for Settlement of an Annual Revenue upon His Majesty's Governor within this Province for the time being, an Impost of one Shilling per Hoghead of Tobacco is by the said Act appropriated for the Use and Support of the Government of Maryland; My Will and Pleasure is that toward your maintenance in the Government of our said Province you take to your own use the Sum of one Thousand Pounds a Year by half yearly or Quarterly Payments to be paid you by my Agent and Receiver General out of the said Impost, having given his Instructions for that purpose.

27.) And you are to recommend unto the General Assembly the raising of such Supplies from time to time as may be sufficient for defraying the other necessary Charges of our Government.

28.) You are to take great care in appointing just and
