Duly qualified Persons for the Employment of Naval Officers.

- 29.) You shall not commit the care of those Employments unto Persons much concerned in Trade who may be apt to be thereby by apid from their respective Dutys.
- 30.) You shall take care that each of the Persons appointed by You to the said Employments of Naval officers and Collectors of the Dutys on Tobaccos and Tonnage of Ships, be sworn to Execute faithfully and diligently their respective offices in their own Persons, not by Deputyes, unless in cases of absolute necessity, and that those Deputyes be then likewise sworn to be faithfull and diligent in the Execution of their respective offices; and that each of the said officers or their Deputyes be required accordingly to give their attendance at such certain times and places as you with the advice of our said Council shall direct.
- 31.) You are not to permit any charge whatsoever to be imputed in any case for levying money or the value of money whereby the same had not been liable to be accounted for unto me here in England.
- 32.) You are to take care that Fair Books of accounts of all Receipts and payments of all such money be duly Kept and the Truth thereof attested upon Oath and that the said Book be transmitted every half year or often to me or Vice Admiralty according
