

England to be laid before me; and Duplicates thereof by the next conveyance, in which Book there shall be specified every Particular Sum raised or disposed of, together with the names of the persons to whom any Payment shall be made, to the End I may be satisfied of the Right and due application of the publick revenue of our said Province.

33.) And it is my express will and Pleasure that no Law for raising any Imposition on wines and other strong liquors be made to continue for less than one whole Year as also that all other Laws whatsoever for the good Government and Support of our said Province be made indefinite and without limitation of time except the same be for a Temporary End, and which shall expire and have its full Effect within a certain time.

34.) You shall not remitt any Fines or Forfeitures whatsoever above the sum of Ten Pounds nor dispose of any fines or Forfeitures, until upon signifying unto me or our Secretary residing in England to be laid before me, the nature of the offence and the occasion of such Fines and Forfeitures with the Particular Sums or Value thereof, which you are to do with all speed, and until you shall have received my Directions therein; that you may in the mean time suspend the Payment of the said Fines and Forfeitures, with the particular Sums or Value thereof, which you are to do And you are likewise to transmit an account of all Escheats which you are to receive from the Persons employed for this service for my Information.
