

of all such Acts and Publick orders as shall be made from time to time, together with a Copy of the Journals of the Council, to the End the same may be transmitted unto me or to our Secretary residing in England to be laid before me as above directed.

36.) You are also to require from the Clerk of the Assembly or other proper Officer Transcripts of all the Journals and other Proceedings of the said Assembly from time to time, to the End the same may in like manner be transmitted as aforesaid.

37.) You shall not displace any of the Judges, Justices, Sheriffs or other Officers or Ministers within our said Province, without good and sufficient cause, to be signified to me or our Secretary residing in England to be laid before me.

38.) And to prevent Arbitrary Removals of Judges and Justices of the Peace, You shall not express any Limitation of time in the Commissions which you are to grant with the advice and consent of our said Council, to Persons fitt for those Employments; Nor shall you execute your self or by Deputy any of the said offices nor suffer any Person to execute more offices than one by Deputy.

39.) Whereas I have granted my Commission to my beloved Uncle The Hon^{ble} Cecilius Calvert Esq^r as Secretary of our Province of Maryland under my Great Seal at Armes, giving him Power to appoint his Deputy, to act
