

49) You shall likewise cause an exact account to be kept of all Persons born Christened and Buried, and you shall yearly send fair Abstracts thereof to me or our Secretary residing in England to be laid before me.

50) You shall take care that the Militia consisting of Planters and Christian Servants be when required well and fitly provided with Arms, for the Support of which you are at all times, to recommend the same to Both Houses of Assembly; and also to take care that they be listed under good officers, and when, and as often as shall be thought fitt mustered and Trained, whereby they may be in a better readiness for the Defence of our said Province under Your Government; and you are to use your utmost Endeavours that such Planters do each of them keep such a number of white Servants as by Law is directed, and that they appear in Arms at all such times as they shall be required.

51) You are to take special care that neither the frequency nor unreasonableness of remote marches, musters and Trainings, be an unnecessary impediment to the Affairs of the Inhabitants.

52) You shall not upon any occasion whatsoever Establish or put in Execution any Articles of war or other Law Martial upon any His Majesty's Subjects my good Tenants or Inhabitants of our said Province, without the Advice and consent of our Council here.
