

53.) And for the greater Security of our said Province
you are to appoint Fitt officers and Commanders in the
several Parts of the Country Bordering upon the Indians,
and in case of any Invasion from the Indians, you are
to communicate the same immediately to Both Houses
of Assembly, that they may provide for defraying the
Charges of opposing the same.

54.) You are to demand an Account from all Persons
concerned, of the Arms, ammunition and stores in our
said Province, as likewise of what have been or may
be bought with the Publick money for the service of
our said Province, and how the same have been employed,
and whether any of them ^{and how many} of them have been sold,
spent, Lost, Decayed or Disposed of and to whom and to
what uses; which account is to commence from the
time that the last account was delivered into the late
Lieutenant Governor of our said Province, and you are
to be transmit the said account to me or our Secretary
residing in England to be laid before me.

55.) YOU shall take an Inventory of all Arms, am-
munition and stores remaining in any of our Maga-
zines or Garisons in our said Province, and transmit
the said accounts and Inventory to me or our Secretary
residing in England, to be laid before me, with all speed
after your Arrival, and the like Inventory afterwards
when any alteration shall arise therein; which accounts
are to Express the Particulars of Ordnance, Carriages, Balls Powder
and all other sorts of Arms and ammunition in our Publick store,
at your said Arrival, and so from time to time of what shall be
bought with the Publick money or sent to be replaced by His
Majestys order in lieu of those supplied by our said Province
for
