

of our Council of State as may be most acceptable to the Generality of the Inhabitants.

60.) You are to give all due Encouragement and Invitation to Merchants and others who shall bring Trade into our said Province, or any way contribute to the Advantage thereof

61.) You are from time to time to send unto Me or our Secretary residing in England to be laid before me, an account of what are the chief Products of our said Province, what new Improvements are made therein by the Industry of the Inhabitants or Planters, and what further Improvements You conceive may be made, or Advantages gained by Trade; and which way I may contribute thereunto.

62.) My will and Pleasure is that Appeals be permitted to be made in cases of Error from the Courts in our said Province unto You and the Council there, and in Your absence from Your said Province, to the Commander in chief for the time being and the said Council, in civil causes, wherein such of our said Council as shall be at that time Judges of the Court from whence such Appeal shall be made to You our Lieutenant Governor and Council, or to the Commander in chief for the time being and Council as aforesaid; shall not be permitted to vote upon the said Appeal, but they may nevertheless be present at the Hearing thereof to give the Reasons of the Judgment given by them in the cause of whom such Appeal shall be made.
