Judgment or sentence of You our Lieutenant Governor
or the Commander in Chief for the time being and
Council as aforesaid, my will and Pleasure is, that they
may then appeal to me for further consideration
thereof; Provided the sum or value so appealed for
unto me do Exceed Three Hundred pounds Sterling, and
that such appeal be made within fourteen days
after sentence, and good Security given by the Appellant
that he will effectually prosecute the same and answer
the condemnation, as also pay such costs and Damages
as shall be awarded by me in case the sentence of You,
or the Commander in Chief for the time being and Council
be affirmed; and provided also, that Execution be not sus=
pended by Reason of any such Appeal unto me. But in
this I give You a discretionary Power in regard to the Three=
hundred pounds by Appeal or a lesser sum, as You and the
Council of state shall think most adviseable.

64.) AND in as much as it may not be fitt that
appeals be too frequently and for too small a value
brought unto our Lieutenant Governor and Council,
You shall therefore with the advice of our said Council
propose a Law to be passed in case no such Law is yet in
being, wherein the method and limitation of Appeals
unto our Lieutenant Governor and Council may be settled
and restrained in such manner as shall be found found
most convenient and easy to His Majesty's Subjects, my
good Tenants in Maryland
